What is the Accessible Trick or Treating?

Accessible Trick or Treating is a program that helps make trick or treating easier for children and adults with disabilities. Treat Accessibly lawn signs show the homeowner is choosing to give out or place candy in an accessible location, such as the bottom of the stairs or driveway.
